The Cape Charles Cup is **THE** Cruising event for serious Racers
and **THE** Racing event for serious Cruisers!

The Saturday leg is from Little Creek to Cape Charles. Enjoy the after-race party at The Oyster Farm Marina at Kings Creek, have dinner and drinks with friends, and sightsee or shop at the marina or in Cape Charles. Call Oyster Farm Marina for slip reservations at (757) 331-8640. You must be entered to obtain a slip – please allow 3 business days after entering before you call for reservations. Docking at Cape Charles Harbor continues to be an excellent option for those who may be concerned about channel depth; (757) 331-2357. Shuttle service will be available to and from the Cape Charles Harbor Marina.

Entry Fee: \$95.00 if received by July 17, \$145 if received thereafter. Please provide a picture of the boat and/or crew to be included in the yearbook (pictures must be e-mailed to CCCPics@broadbaysailing.org by July 17 to be included, unless your boat was pictured in last year's Cape Charles Cup Yearbook). Entry fee includes registration, one Cape Charles Cup hat and tee shirt, four Saturday dinner tickets, a Cape Charles Cup skipper's bag loaded with useful and/or interesting stuff, a great party at Oyster Farm Marina on Saturday, and the final trophy presentation and celebration on Tuesday, September 18th.

Entries and Deadline: Online entry at www.CCCup.net. **Entries close at 1200 hours on August 6th.**

Skippers' Meeting: Social @ 1800 hours – Skippers' Meeting @ 1830 hours (sharp!) on Friday, August 10th at Bay Point Marina Gazebo.

Courses: Saturday: Starting on the north side of the Thimble Shoal Channel approximately 2 miles north of "1LC" and finishing at the Cape Charles entrance buoy. Sunday: Starting in the vicinity of the Cape Charles entrance buoy and finishing off Buckroe. In the event of light air, the race committee may relocate the starting line closer to the first mark and/or shorten course at the mark.

Divisions: PHRF, Cruising, CRCA, CMA/Multihull, and CHESSS as described below.

PHRF A, B, C, N (2HS-double headsails allowed) and N (1HS-single headsail only) with current PHRF rating (www.phrfchesbay.org). PHRF Nonspinnaker classes will receive an 18 sec/mi handicap bonus for Cape Charles Cup Trophy calculations. Cruising (single headsail only), open to monohull boats that do not have a valid PHRF rating and/or skippers that race only occasionally (courtesy rating available from race organizers and shall not be subject to challenge). Handicap adjustments will be made for previous multiple race winners in the Cruising Division. CRCA with valid rating (<https://chesrca.weebly.com/>). CMA/Multihull (no beach-launched vessels) with valid rating (courtesy ratings will be assigned by CMA: <http://www.chesapeake-multihulls.org/>). CHESSS (www.chbaysss.org). Classes with 6 or fewer entries may be combined for awards and/or starting.

Time: First Flag = 1000 hours Saturday and Sunday.

Rules: The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*. All monohulls must meet PHRF of the Chesapeake's Safety Equipment Requirements Category Ches Bay (4P), which can be downloaded at http://www.phrfchesbay.org/docs/PHRF_Equip_Regs_v2.pdf. All multihulls must meet equipment requirements described in 2018-2019 ISAF Offshore Special Regulations, which can be downloaded at [http://www.sailing.org/tools/documents/WorldSailingOffshoreSpecialRegulations20182019180104-\[23449\].pdf](http://www.sailing.org/tools/documents/WorldSailingOffshoreSpecialRegulations20182019180104-[23449].pdf).

Prizes: Daily class awards based on number of entries. Cape Charles Cup awards for the best total corrected time (Divisions with at least 13 entries). Saturday trophies awarded at the post-race party. Sunday and overall trophies awarded at the September 18th BBSA meeting at The Lagoon at Bay Point Marina.

Entry Fee: \$95.00 per boat, received on or before July 17, 2018. Entries received later MUST include a late fee of \$50.00. Entries close at 1200 hours on August 6th. If both races are cancelled for any reason: 1) \$25.00 will be credited to the registered yacht's 2019 entry fees; 2) purchase price of additional dinner tickets will be refunded; and 3) paid Cape Charles Cup logo items ordered at registration will be provided at the skipper's meeting or the first opportunity.

RELEASE OF LIABILITY

In consideration of the undersigned's participation in Broad Bay Sailing Association ("BBSA") Regattas ("the Regatta") and hosted by BBSA (the "Host") on August 11-12, 2018, the undersigned participant ("Participant"), on behalf of themselves and their respective heirs, executors, administrators, personal representatives and next of kin (collectively with Participant, "Releasers"), hereby forever waive, release and discharge the Host and their respective parents, subsidiaries, affiliates, owners, members, managers, employees, officers, directors, agents, representatives, successors and assigns (each a "Released Party") from any and all claims, demands, damages, judgments, executions, rights of action or causes of action, present or future, whether the same be known, anticipated or unanticipated, which a Releaser may have, or claim to have, against any Released Party resulting from death, personal injury, property damage or other loss Releaser may sustain as a result of participating in the Regatta or other activities related thereto.

THIS RELEASE IS INTENDED TO DISCHARGE EACH RELEASED PARTY FROM ANY AND ALL LIABILITY ARISING OUT OF OR CONNECTED IN ANY WAY WITH RELEASOR'S PARTICIPATION IN THE REGATTA EVEN IF THAT LIABILITY ARISES OUT OF NEGLIGENCE OR CARELESSNESS ON THE PART OF ANY RELEASED PARTY.

Releasers hereby acknowledge that serious accidents occasionally occur during sailing activities and that mortal or serious personal injuries and/or property damage or other loss may result from participation in the Regatta, including, but not limited to, exposure to any third parties activities nearby, such as the U.S. Navy exercises that are performed in the same waters as the Regatta. Releasers knowingly assume all risks of participation in the Regatta, including all risk of personal injury and loss of or damage to the Releasers or their property, including further injury sustained as the result of the efforts of third parties who come to the aid of Releaser(s) if injured as a result of participation in the Regatta, and release all other persons and entities mentioned above who might otherwise be liable to Releasers. Releasers agree to abide by all rules of the Host in connection with participation in the Regatta and understand that the failure to observe and obey such rules may result in instant revocation of Releaser's(s') right to participate in the Regatta.
