Saturday – Race from Little Creek to Cape Charles. First gun at 1000. Party at Bay Creek Marina beginning at 1730.

Sunday - Race back across the Bay, finishing off Buckroe. First gun at 0900. Party at Bay Point Marina on Little Creek beginning at 1630.

Entry Fee - \$50.00 if received by August 1, \$75 if received later. Entries received by August 1 will have a picture of the boat and/or crew included in the Cape Charles Cup yearbook. Classes – PHRF: A, B, C, and separate Nonspin classes for single and double headsails. (Current PHRF valid rating required)

One or more Cruising Classes with committee-assigned handicaps.

Anyone Can Win – PHRF Nonspinnaker participants will receive an 18 sec/mi handicap bonus for Cape Charles Cup PHRF Division Trophy calculations.

Time - First Flag: 1000 hours Saturday;
0900 hours Sunday.

Prizes - Daily class awards based on number of entries. Cape Charles Cups for the best total corrected time in PHRF and Cruising divisions (keeper trophies are traditional big brass Weems and Plath yacht lamps, plus winners' names on the perpetual).
