10th CAPE CHARLES CUP BIG SUCCESS

Racers and Organizers Defy Crummy Weather

At arguably one of the best skippers meetings held on the southern Bay this summer, racers, friends, and BBSA volunteers stared down the threat of rain and kicked off their annual Cape Charles event with enthusiasm and determination.

And, the Skippers Meeting was just the beginning. Undeterred by winds in the high teens and 4 foot waves on Saturday morning, the racers battled their way across the Bay to Cape Charles and the relatively calm waters of the Eastern Shore side. Light, intermittent rain did not dampen the Saturday Night festivities at Kings Creek Marina - music, dancing, food, drink, and awards went as scheduled and even better than expected. Sunday brought lower winds, but some rain and fog for the race back to Buckroe at Hampton.

Seventy-three (73) boats, skippers, and crew, did the 2013 Cape Charles Cup - 28 competed in the PHRF Division, 43 in Cruising, and 2 in Multihull. The Cape Charles Cup Weems and Plath brass lantern trophies will be presented at the September 17th BBSA Meeting at The Lagoon Restaurant, Little Creek - Norfolk. Winners of the coveted awards are: PHRF Division - Phil Briggs, *Feather*; Cruising Division: Jim Beaudry, *Black Dog*. Fleet trophies for the Sunday race also will be presented.

Cape Charles Cup has become the signature BBSA event. A lot of folks contribute time, energy, worry, and dedication to make this event what it is.
