Leo Wardrup Memorial Cape Charles Cup Race Information – Hank Giffin:

The Cape Charles Cup Committee has renamed the race in Leo Wardrup's memory. Leo was a major influence in resurrecting the race in 2004, and was very proud of the opportunity it gave young sailors to experience the rigors of open water sailing. He was also a big proponent of the donation the CCC made the last few years to the Sail Nauticus program, which exposes underprivileged youth to sailing on the Norfolk waterfront. Those donations came from raffle, auction, and T shirt sales at the race. The race will now be called the Leo Wardrup Memorial Cape Charles Cup.

The **Early-Bird entry date** to get the reduced entry fee and dinner tickets is coming up soon – **July 23**rd. It also ensures you will get your choice of T-Shirt sizes.

Classes – PHRF: A, B, C, and separate Nonspin classes for single and double headsails. (Current PHRF valid rating required) Several Cruising Classes and a Multihull Class with committee-assigned handicaps.

Anyone Can Win – PHRF Nonspinnaker participants will receive an 18 sec/mi handicap bonus for Cape Charles Cup PHRF Division Trophy calculations.

Prizes - Daily class awards based on number of entries. Cape Charles Cups for the best total corrected time in PHRF, Cruising and Multihull divisions (13 boat minimum). Keeper trophies are traditional big brass Weems and Plath yacht lamps, plus winning boats' names on the perpetual trophy.
