2022 Cruising Captain: Eric Brinsfield



While planning for our cruise and during our cruise to the Bahamas, we have noticed that many new cruisers on the radio and on Facebook groups are not prepared. We can help you prepare if you are hoping to go for a long cruise someday.

Also, we find it difficult to schedule all the training sessions because of all the other competing activities. Let us know if you prefer weekend or weeknight training sessions.

Prior to our training sessions, I will make one recommendation to cruisers and potential cruisers regardless of whether you plan to use the ICW or not. Check out Bob423, his blog at Bob423 ICW

<u>Tracks and Routes (bobicw.blogspot.com)</u> or his guide book. He explains how to cruise down the ICW and provides guidance on problem areas along the way. He even shares his safe tracks from Norfolk to Florida, which you can download. The first few chapters of his book cover how to prepare your boat for cruising and the remainder talks about shoaling areas and points of interest in the ICW. I learned most of this information the hard way over the years and we tend to go offshore more than inside, but I do enjoy reading his material. Be sure to pay attention to his discussions of AquaMap (https://www.aquamap.app).


BBSA Name Tags, Mary Anne Greblunas:
