## **SBRW 2024 RACING PROGRAM**

### **PHRF and ONE-DESIGN FLEETS**

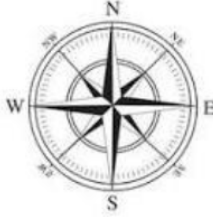
- ✦ All racing in the Harbor on two circles
- ✦ Fleets sub-divided to provide close, competitive racing
  - ✦ Multiple windward/leeward races with long/short weather marks and gates
  - ✦ Experienced RC and mark boats to keep things square, fair, and moving
  - ✦ 8–11 head knockin', gear bustin' race series
- ✦ Schedule:
  - Friday – Multiple windward/leewards (3-4 races)
  - Saturday – Multiple windward/leewards (3-4 races)
  - Sunday – Multiple windward/leewards (2-3 races)
- ✦ *PHRF and ONE-DESIGN fleets will be divided between two racing circles in such a way as to provide close, competitive racing on appropriate courses for all fleets.*
- ✦ One Design classes must have at least four (4) boats entered and paid by May 15<sup>th</sup>.

### **CRUISING FLEETS (3) - SBRW Cruising, PHRF Cruising (Spin & Non-Spin)**

- ✦ Two days of racing...four nights of parties...for a reduced entry fee
- ✦ All racing in the Bay off Buckroe / Salt Ponds
- ✦ Experienced race committee
- ✦ Fleets sub-divided as appropriate for good, fun racing
- ✦ Schedule:
  - Saturday and Sunday = One Open course, middle distance race each day
  - No windward-leeward courses
  - Both races will also count toward the Southern Bay Distance Racing Series
  - Appropriate course lengths for fleets of various sizes
  - Option to race in the harbor if Bay too rough

- ✓ Different course lengths for different fleets...all designed to last 2.5 to 3.5 hours.
- ✓ Ability to move racing inside the harbor if the seas are too rough in the Bay.
- ✓ Separate trophies for each fleet each day... plus Boat of the Day Flag award.

## 1. Traditional SBRW CRUISING FLEET

\*\* SBRW Cruising Rating provided absolutely **FREE**.

\*\* Fleet sub-divided into SBRW Cruising A (faster group) and B (slower group).

- Started and scored separately. Separate trophies.
- Courses are different lengths to provide everyone with a great day of racing.

## 2. Two **NEW** PHRF CRUISING FLEET Options

\*\* All PHRF Cruising Rating Certificates are absolutely **FREE** (but you must apply).

\*\* Both have a few limitations to reduce costs and complexity of racing.

- Boats may not have upwind SA/D ratio of less than 22 (i.e. no Sport Boats).
- Limitations on sail material (i.e. no Kevlar, etc.) and number of sails allowed.
- Number of crew limited to number of berths.
- Boats must race in "Cruising Configurations" (i.e. doors, tables, etc. in place)

### ⚓ PHRF CRUISING NON-SPINNAKER (No spinnakers allowed)

- One jib under 109% and one jib over 109% .
- One headsail up at a time, please.

### ⚓ PHRF CRUISING SPINNAKER (The spinnaker experience)

- No limit on type of spinnaker (symmetrical, asymmetrical, cruising).
- Headsail fabric and sizes permitted are still limited.

### **From the Cruiser Cockpit 2024 Cruising Captain: David Midkiff**

The weather is getting warmer, and spring is almost here, time to start planning for cruising!

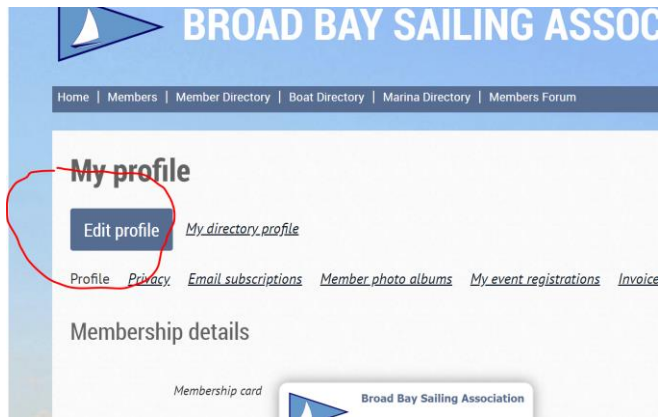

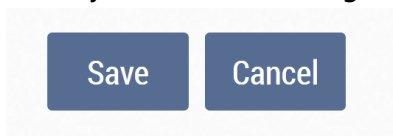
