Entry Fee: \$135.00 if received by **July 8th**; \$195.00 if received thereafter; \$95.00 for new boat owners. In accordance with the process described in your event registration confirmation email, provide a photo of your boat by July 21st to be included in the yearbook. Entry fee includes registration, one Cape Charles Cup hat and short sleeve tee shirt, two Saturday dinner tickets, and a Cape Charles Cup skipper's bag loaded with useful and interesting stuff. Skipper's social and awards social are included.

Competitors' Meeting: Social @ 1800 hours – **Skippers' Meeting @ 1830 hours** on Friday, August 9th at East Beach Bayfront Club. 4550 E. Beach Dr. Norfolk, VA 23518. Skipper plus one guest invited.

Divisions: **PHRF A, B, C, N** (2HS-double headsails allowed) and **N** (1HS-single headsail only) with current PHRF rating (www.phrfchesbay.org). PHRF Non spinnaker classes will receive an 18 sec/mi handicap bonus for Cape Charles Cup Trophy calculations. **ORC Performance Cruiser (spin)** with [valid ORC certificate](#) and conforming to [ORC Cruiser configuration requirements](#). **Cruising** (single headsail only), open to monohull boats that do not have a valid PHRF rating and/or skippers that race only occasionally (courtesy rating available from race organizers and shall not be subject to challenge). **PHRF Cruising (spin and non-spin)** with valid PHRF Cruising rating, **CMA/Multihull** (no beach-launched vessels) with valid rating (courtesy ratings will be assigned by CMA: <http://www.chesapeakemultihulls.org/>). A division must have 5 entries by August 2nd to be included.

Courses:

For PHRF Racing and ORC Performance Cruiser: Saturday: The start is on the north side of the Thimble Shoal Channel approximately 2 miles north of "1LC" and finishing at the Cape Charles entrance buoy.

Sunday: Starting in the vicinity of the Cape Charles entrance buoy and finishing off Buckroe.

For Cruising, PHRF Cruising, and CMA/Multihull: Saturday: The start is on the north side of the Thimble Shoal Channel approximately 4 miles north of "1LC" and finishing at the Cape Charles entrance buoy.

Sunday: Starting 2 miles west of the Cape Charles entrance buoy and finishing off Buckroe.

For either day or start, the race committee may shorten the courses described above in the event of light air.

Time: First Flag = 1000 hours Saturday and Sunday.

Rules: The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*. All monohulls must meet [US Sailing Safety Equipment Requirements for Near Shore-Monohull](#) as modified in the Sailing Instructions. All multihulls must meet [US Sailing Safety Equipment Requirements for Near Shore-Multihull](#) as modified in the Sailing Instructions.

Prizes: Daily class awards based on number of entries. Cape Charles Cup awards for the best total corrected time (Divisions with at least 11 entries). Saturday trophies awarded at the Saturday night social. Sunday and overall trophies awarded at an awards social on Tuesday, September 17, 2024 at AJ Gators, 9575 Shore Dr., Norfolk.
