Cape Charles Cup is the only "destination" weekend regatta on the southern Chesapeake Bay.

With plenty of racing competition plus three "signature socials", including the Saturday post-race festivities at The Oyster Farm Marina at Kings Creek, there is truly something for everyone.

BOTH races are part of the Southern Bay Distance Racing Series!

Friday – Skipper's Meeting. Finger food, beer, wine and sea stories begin at 1800 at the East Beach Clubhouse, 4550 E Beach Dr, Norfolk, VA. Skippers' Meeting starts at 1830.

Saturday – Race from Little

Creek to Cape Charles (first gun at 1000). Post-race buffet supper, awards ceremony, and awesome social at The Oyster Farm Marina.

Sunday - Race back across Bay to Buckroe Beach (first gun at 1000).

Entry Fee - \$135 if received by July 8th, \$195 if received later. First time owners fee is \$95. Entries received by July 19th will have a picture of the boat and/or crew included in the Cape Charles Cup yearbook and website. Photo instructions will be provided when you register. (Send photo to CCCpics@broadbaysailing.org by July 19th) Entry fee includes registration, hat, tee shirt, two Saturday dinner tickets, skipper's bag, and our famous SOCIALS!

Docking — Dock at Oyster Farm Marina to be closer to the after-race social and awards or Cape Charles Harbor for a DEEP-WATER solution. A slip reservation will be made for you at the location you request on the race entry form. There's no need to call the marina to make a separate reservation. Skippers are responsible for their slip fees and charges.

Enjoy race hospitality and Sunday morning munchies at both marinas! There will also be a fast and reliable shuttle service on Saturday between Oyster Farm Marina and Cape Charles Harbor.

Classes – PHRF: A, B, C, Nonspin single and double headsails, Cruising classes, ORC Performance Cruiser, and Multihull/CMA with committee-assigned handicaps.

Anyone Can Win – PHRF Nonspin participants will receive an 18 sec/mi handicap bonus for Cape Charles Cup PHRF Division Trophy calculations.

Prizes - Daily class awards based on number of entries. Cape Charles Cups for the best total corrected time in PHRF, Cruising, CMA/Multihull, and ORC Performance Cruiser divisions (13 boat minimum). Keeper trophies are traditional big brass Weems and Plath yacht lamps. The winning boats' names will be put on the perpetual trophy awarded at the final party in September.
