There may be multiple courses for eligible one-design classes. A Portsmouth Yardstick handicapped class will be offered for boats who do not have enough boats for a one-design class. Advance registration is expected by all participants on Regatta Network. Expected classes include Flying Scot, ILCA 6, ILCA 7, Melges 15, Hampton One Design, San Juan 21, Weta, Windmill, Optimist (Red, Blue, White and Green fleets) & Portsmouth Handicap.

Ware River Yacht Club is the annual host of the VIRGINIA GOVERNORS CUP REGATTA. This will be a multiclass regatta, with boats from many one designs, including Hampton One Design, Albacore, Lasers, Buccaneers, Optimists. The weekend regatta includes two days of racing, a big party on Saturday night, and lots of fun to be had by all. This will be the 60th year for this WRYC event and they will surely do it right!

From Mayo Tabb comes word that The PHRF OF THE CHESAPEAKE is updating website content. Click on <u>www.phrfchesbay.org</u> The key areas regarding ratings, rules and safety have been updated. Concerning the NEW PHR<u>F CRUISING CLASS certificates:</u>

Yacht with a Cruising Class certificate can race under that certificate in a regular PHRF Class. However a Yacht with a regular PHRF certificate cannot race under that certificate in a Cruising Class because the OA have no way of determining if the yacht complies with the additional Cruising Class requirements especially Sail Area to Displacement and sail material construction. To boil it down – To race in the PHRF CRUISING Class (Spinnaker or Non-Spinnaker), a racer need only obtain a current <u>PHRF of the Chesapeake Cruising certificate</u>. The PHRF Cruising certificate is <u>free</u> and the application is straight forward and easy - click on <u>www.phrfchesbay.org</u> (**NOTE- PHRF Executive Board for 2024:** President-Mayo Tabb; VP Southern Bay-Greg Cutter; VP Northern Bay-Nelson Pemberton; VP Communications-Pat Seidel; Secretary-Glenn Harvey; Treasurer-Jim Raper; Past President-Roger Coney. Contact info for Officers and Handicappers is listed at the website.
