THIS IS NATIONAL MARITIME DAY

2023 CAPE HENRY CUP is in the books! Thirty-five (35) entered this Broad Bay Sailing Association (BBSA) event and twenty-nine (29) sailed Saturday, and what was predicted to be light turned out to be great sailing day on the Bay. Early on, wind speeds hit 18 knots, but diminished throughout to a comfortable 6-8. RESTLESS, **Donna DeSteph and Mick Mihalcoe won the CAPE HENRY CUP**, and it's not the first time either. They won the 2019 Cup too, with *Restless*. The entire history of the Cape Henry Cup is listed beginning with the first in 1974, won by **David Nichol** in *MELLOW YELLOW*, click on https://broadbaysailing.org/CHCResults The Cape Henry Cup is presented to the first place boat with the greatest corrected time differential (figured as a percentage of the first place boat's corrected time) over the second place boat in her class (four boats starting and two boats finishing minimum).

Award presentations will be made during the BBSA Membership Meeting at the Bold Mariner Brewery, 1901 E Ocean View Ave, Norfolk, VA 23503, at 1800 on May 23, 2023.

HYC HOSPICE ONE-DESIGN REGATTA to benefit the Dozoretz Hospice House of Hampton Roads got in

two days of racing - 11 boats sailing in 3 one-design classes, 8 races per class over Saturday and Sunday. The newly minted EDDIE WILLIAMS TROPHY was awarded to its first recipient, Henry Amthor, at the event gathering Saturday night. National Hospice Regatta Alliance official Jean Klutz, who has strong ties in the Hampton Roads area, was on hand. The HYC Hospice contributes to the HAMPTON ROADS HOSPICE HOUSE. This is the first year of association with the National Hospice Regatta Alliance, making HYC Hospice the second of two Hospice Alliance Regattas in Virginia. The Hospice Turkey Shoot, hosted by Rappahannock River YC each fall is a long established event which contributes to support of Northern Neck area Hospice Services. The Turkey Shoot will be September 29-October 1 this year.

2023 HYC Hospice One-Design Regatta:

Peter III, in *CATEPILLAR*, won the 5 boat **Viper 640 class** by 1 point with a string of 1-2-2-2-2-[4]-3. **Mark Wheeler**, *VAPOR TRAILS*, who took 3 first places over the two days, finished 2nd overall with 15 points after throwing out a [5]. Henry Amthor, #227, finished third overall with 16 points after throwing out a [4]. The Vipers got in 8 races, 4 each day, and the competition was tight and probably a prediction of the type of racing coming for the Vipers in SBRW in 2 weeks. The Viper 640 ATLANTIC COAST CHAMPIONSHIPS will be decided at SBRW.

Ray Nugent, *ROCKET J*, won the 3 boat **J24 class**, dominating the group with 5 first places in the 8 races. **Alan Bomar**, *ROUNDABOUT*, was second overall and **Jason Abernathy**. *REFLEX* was 3rd

Latane Montague took the Hampton One-Design (HOD) class of 3 by storm, winning the first 5 races. Jackson Montague, finished second, and Dave and Leigh Chapman were third overall.

- If you are CREW hoping to catch a ride at SBRW, click on the "Crew/Boat/Charter Board". OR, go to the same spot if
 you are a skipper looking for CREW. There are all sorts of boats racing at SBRW, from the PHRF Super A Fleet,
 through all levels of spinnaker as well as Non-Spinnaker. There are J24, Viper 640, and Melges 24 classes on the onedesign course. And, the Cruising fleets do one middle distance race each day, Saturday and Sunday in the Bay off
 Buckroe.

It is a mere 11 more days (Friday, June 2nd) before the racing actually begins. *Then Katie bar the door!* There will be racing, tacking, jibing, and busting down wind.
